With the PDF/UA functionality available in **Papyrus Business Designer**, business administrators can easily create PDF documents that comply to **PDF/Universal Accessibility**, the informal name for ISO 14289, the International Standard for accessible PDF technology.

During the **document design process**, business administrators can quickly switch between the document structure and the **Accessibility view** and optimize the document for users who rely on assistive technologies to access PDF documents.

Intuitive handling of building blocks and tagging, a wide range of accessibility tags and multi-language support for alternative tags smoothly integrate into the document design process, with no technical skills required.

Functions

- Automatic PDF/UA tagging for accessibility can be enabled
- Semantic tags for building blocks: headings, articles, sections, quotes
- Changing of reading order
- Exclusion of building blocks from reading (artifacts)
- Defining alternative texts in multiple languages
- Defining the document name for PDF/UA compliance in multiple languages for international organizations

Accessibility view

- Switch to accessibility view directly within document design
- View list of all output generating building blocks including layouts
- Click for synchronized highlighting in document preview, document structure and reading order

Reading order

- View reading order of building blocks in the accessibility view
- Use drag-and-drop to change the reading order

Tag as headings

- Tag building blocks as heading to support navigation in a document with assistive technologies
- Supported heading levels: 1 to 6

Semantic grouping with sections, articles

- Group related content
- Tag building blocks as article (e.g. chapter)
- Tag building blocks as section (e.g. paragraph and image)

Tag as quotes

- Mark text quoted from another author in the text variant editor

Exclude content from reading

- Tag building blocks as artifacts by drag-and-drop or button
- View all artifacts in a folder

Alternative texts

- Define text to be read out loud for building blocks like images
- Multiple languages
- Define in building block editor or document template

Document title

- Define document title in the document properties
- Supports multiple languages for international organizations
